

How to Make Paper Easter Lilies

You will need...

Paper (white and green)

Green straws

Yellow pipecleaners

Green paper leaves

Sellotape

Scissors

Pencil/pen

Hole-punch

Directions.

- 1). Trace around the hand of your favourite old person at your local rest-home. Cut this out.
- 2). Wrap the handprint around the straw and sellotape.
- 3). Curl the fingers outwards by wrapping the fingers around your pencil or pen.
- 4). Cut a yellow pipecleaner in half. Fold this shortened pipecleaner in two and push this into the top of the straw so that only the two ends can be seen, giving the image of a stamen in the centre of the flower.
- 5). Cut a leaf out of green paper. Hole-punch one end and thread this onto the straw. Sellotape this leaf to the straw to secure it.
- 6). Once you've made a whole bunch of paper Easter lilies out of the residents handprints, put these in a vase to adorn the rest-home lounge. They are a great reminder that friends are like flowers in the garden of life.
