

# How to make Tissue Pockets

## **You will need:**

Two pieces of fabric that look good together

Scissors

Pins

Template

Sewing machine

Iron

## **Directions:**

1). Cut the template out so that you have two pieces – an inside piece and an outside piece.

2). Pin the outside piece (the smaller piece) to the material you have chosen to put on the outside of the tissue pocket. Pin the inside piece (the bigger piece) to the material that will go inside the tissue pocket. Cut these two pieces out.

3). Match these two pieces of material up along the sides that are the shortest on either end, make sure that the back of each piece of material is showing. Pin together. There will be some slack with the bigger piece of material. Don't worry about this at the moment.

4). Sew along the two ends that are pinned and then of course remove the pins.

5). Turn the material inside out. The right side of the material should now be showing. Iron the material flat making sure that the contrasting material showing at either end are even.

6). Fold the two shorter ends into the middle so that they line up with one another. The only material that you should be able to see is the material that will line the inside of the tissue pocket.

7). Pin along the ends so that the folded material is held in place and then sew these two ends.

8). Take the pins out and turn the material inside out. What you are left with is a completed tissue pocket. Iron this. Then you can slip inside it a packet of pocket tissues.
